

## Declaration of Conformity with the EU REACH Regulation

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) on the classification, designation and packaging of materials and mixtures, focuses on the protection of the environment and of people, and on the safe handling of chemicals.

The acronym REACH stands for the **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorisation, and **R**estriction of **C**hemicals. The regulation has been in force since 1 June 2007. Implementation of REACH takes place through ECHA, the European Chemicals Agency, in Helsinki, Finland. All materials and preparations are scheduled to be registered, reviewed, and approved by 1 July 2018; articles as such must not be registered.

Especially questionable substances are either entered on the Candidate Authorization List, or are contained in Attachment XIV of the Regulation; they require a permit or can be restricted for use. For substances on the Candidate Authorization List, information must be provided, as a mandatory requirement, within the supply chain.

The company Feuerherdt GmbH manufactures neither substances nor preparations and, as downstream user, is not subject to registration requirements.

We have directed questions to our suppliers with respect to REACH and have obtained from them confirmations that they observe the REACH Regulation.

This document confirms that the materials used by us do not contain substances from the current Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) (<https://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>) in concentrations of more than 0.1 mass percent, and that we conform to the stipulations in Attachments XIV and XVII of the REACH Regulation.
